1) Have you ever been to the mountains? Where did you go? What was your experience like?

Word

Read Mark 9:2-9

- 1) In what ways were the Law and the prophets given to produce a just and worshipful society?
- 2) How has Jesus fulfilled the purpose of the Law and the prophets?
- 3) What is problematic about treating Jesus, Moses, and Elijah as equals?
- 4) Consider the following statement: *The Law and the Prophets were the lesser lights in the pre-Christ night sky. They were the moon and stars. Israel could grope forward by their dim light...But with Christ morning has broken! The new day has dawned!* How do these metaphors help explain the supremacy of Jesus over the Law and Prophets?
- 5) The Bible is not a flat text. In what ways has Jesus caused us to rethink and reimagine the Old Testament?
- 6) What is the difference between "biblical principles" and the "truth of Christ"?
- 7) How do you respond when you read something in the Old Testament that seems to sound different than the teachings of Jesus?
